## **Volunteer Positions**

Ministry Volunteer: A person volunteering on the grounds when campers are present to help with guest needs. These volunteers may have contact with camp guests and so a background check will be done prior to volunteering.

Facility & Grounds Volunteer: A person volunteering on the grounds when no campers are present to help improve the facilities and grounds. These volunteers will not have contact with camp guests.

## Volunteer Policy

Consumption of alcoholic beverages and illegal use of drugs are prohibited on the grounds.

Smoking is only allowed outdoors. Smoking in buildings is not allowed. Cigarette butts must be disposed of in a proper manner and not on the ground.

Firearms and fireworks are not allowed on the grounds without prior permission.

Volunteers will call the office (641)-398–2488 or the Guest Services Coordinator (641)-220-9559 prior to arrival. We do not want to waste your valuable time that you have so graciously given us and want projects ready for your arrival.

As a Christian organization we want to honor the Sabbath as schedule allows. Therefore, we will not work Sunday's unless providing guest needs is required.

Volunteers are allowed to bring their camper/RV for free overnight stays if:

It does not interfere with guest group rentals Volunteer a minimum of 3 hrs. per day Volunteer a minimum of 15 hrs. per week

Ministry Volunteers will have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and be willing to give witness, in love, to others in his name.
